AUTHORIZATION & RELEASE: I understand and agree that:
I will abide by all Board policies and administrative guidelines while on duty for East Lansing Public Schools, including the Tobacco-Free Schools Act prohibiting the use of tobacco products at all times in all buildings and grounds.
I realize that as a volunteer I am not in any manner considered an employee of the District or entitled to any benefits provided to employees. I understand that, although I am covered under the District's liability insurance policy, I am not covered by its health insurance policy nor am I eligible for workers' compensation. Should I become ill or suffer an accident while doing volunteer work for the District, I agree that I shall be responsible for any and all hospital and medical charges that may accrue.
I understand that volunteers in private cars sometimes provide transportation for field trips and extra curricular activities. The District provides liability coverage for employees but no insurance or liability coverage for the ownership, maintenance, operational expenses, or any injury or damages to people or property that may occur in any manner from the use of non-school vehicles. Drivers under the age of 18 cannot serve as volunteer drivers for school related functions.
I further understand that Michigan law prohibits a school district from employing or allowing to serve as a volunteer, in any capacity, a person convicted of a listed offense. 'Listed offenses", as well as other information on this legislation, may be found at the following website: www.michigan.gov. In addition, the law further requires school district to dismiss any employee or volunteer who is listed on the sex offenders' registry. If you have been convicted of a felony other than a listed offense or an offense which requires your name to be listed on the sex offenders' registry, you will be dismissed immediately.
I further release East Lansing Public Schools, its Board of Education, individual Board of Education members, employees and agents, and the entities to which the criminal history record information is released, to the maximum extent permitted by law. Also from any and all liability for any damages, whatever their nature, which may result as a consequence of my volunteer services.
